AYF Eligibility

- ◆ Participation in AYF 21 is open to students who belong to AYF or PAC partner schools or countries
- ◆ Applicants must have good English proficiency plus an interest in Asian peoples, cultures and issues
- ◆ Applicants should be Asian country nationals or citizens from the Asia-Pacific region

AYF Teacher Advisors

- ◆ Students from AYF partner schools & nations must be endorsed by an AYF Teacher Advisor.
- ◆ Please direct all questions to the AYF Advisor at your university or your AYF country coordinator

Notice of Acceptance & Invitation Letter

- ◆ Your participation in AYF will be officially confirmed in summer 2018.
- ◆ All students selected will be sent an AYF Invitation letter so they can apply for a visa to Japan

Japanese Visa

- ◆ Participants who require a visa to enter Japan must apply for this at their local Japanese embassy
- ◆ AYF will supply them with documents needed for their Japan visa (AYF information, daily schedule...)

TRAVEL COSTS and PARTICIPATION FEE

Asian participants who join the 21st Asian Youth Forum are required to pay 2 costs:

- (1) round-trip transportation expenses from their home country to Kyoto, Japan
- (2) a participation fee of US \$400 to cover 1 week's accommodation, meals and program expenses.

Participants with financial needs should work with their teachers and other AYF students in their university or country to find funding (e.g., through their school, organizations, companies or their own fund-raising).
