communication and leadership skills using English-as-a-global-language.

College students (age 18 – 25) from Japan and nations in Asia. Students should have good proficiency in English and an interest in Asian peoples, cultures and countries.

WHEN: The 21<sup>st</sup> Asian Youth Forum will be a 1-week event from October 31 – November 6.

WHERE: AYF 21 will be held in Kyoto, Japan hosted by Kyoto University of Foreign Studies.
