

# KOTESOL 2014 Election Details

1. All candidates have submitted nominations with endorsement from five KOTESOL members in good standing.
2. All candidates meet the requirements for candidacy (see KOTESOL Bylaws Article V, Section 3).
3. Only current KOTESOL Members (membership expiry after October 5 2014) are eligible to cast a ballot. That list was presented prior to the conference, and is augmented half-daily by memberships paid at the conference.
4. Policies determining election of candidates are specified in KOTESOL Bylaws (Article VII) and Robert's Rules of Order Newly Revised (11<sup>th</sup> Edition). Of note, blank ballots shall be treated as abstention (p. 415).
